

Booking details

For groups of 10 or more paying visitors, the group organiser will be offered FREE admission and, where relevant, the coach driver will be offered FREE admission and a hot drink.

Admission (during normal opening times):
Adult £4.50, Concession £3.50, Child FREE*
*Up to 2 children free with 1 full paying adult or concession – additional children £1 per child.

Admission with guided tour
(during normal opening times):
Adult £5.50, Concession £4.50, Child £1

The above prices apply for groups of 10 or more paying visitors and are for a single visit ticket. For guided tours there is a minimum charge based on 10 paying adults. There is a **supplement of £1 per person for visits outside of normal opening hours.**

Tea/coffee and cake can be pre-booked for £3.50 per person. A **Vintage Afternoon Tea** is available to groups. Using vintage china the tea includes sandwiches, scones with jam and cream, a selection of cakes and tea or coffee. Other refreshment options are available. Please contact the museum for details and prices.


Why not try a group package for a **personal celebration or company outing with a difference.**

Guided tours

A special guided tour is available for groups of 10 or more. Groups are offered a fascinating insight into the history of this Grade II* listed Elizabethan townhouse, and a glimpse into the lives of the people who lived and worked here. They include the eccentric shopkeeper who sold stationery and founded the town's penny bank, and the redoubtable Mrs King.

The tour takes approximately 45 minutes, covering the period rooms and shop settings on the ground floor, after which groups are free to explore the four exhibition galleries upstairs. Browse in the museum shop, enjoy the beautiful walled garden and indulge yourself with a generous slice of cake in the tearoom.

Tours of the Stores is a 30 minute talk about the collections held by the museum plus a 20 minute behind the scenes tour of the new museum stores.

House & garden

The Priest's House Museum & Garden is located in the heart of the beautiful market town of Wimborne Minster.

Using collections rich in archaeology and costume, and childhood and local history material, the museum tells the story of East Dorset. Period rooms, from a 17th century hall to the working Victorian kitchen, show how life and work has changed in this historic townhouse. There are 10 galleries to explore. Displays include audio descriptions and children's activities.

A beautiful walled garden, gift shop and tearoom complete any visit.
